



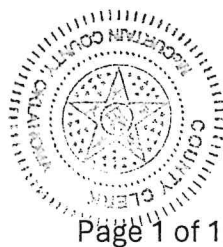
NOTICE OF POSSIBLE QUORUM

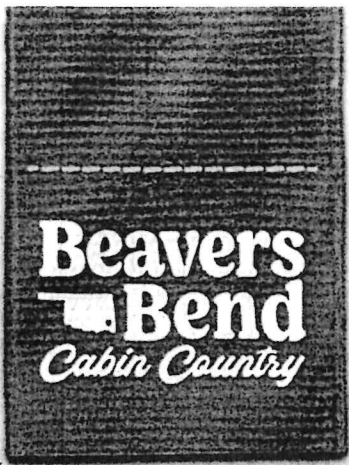

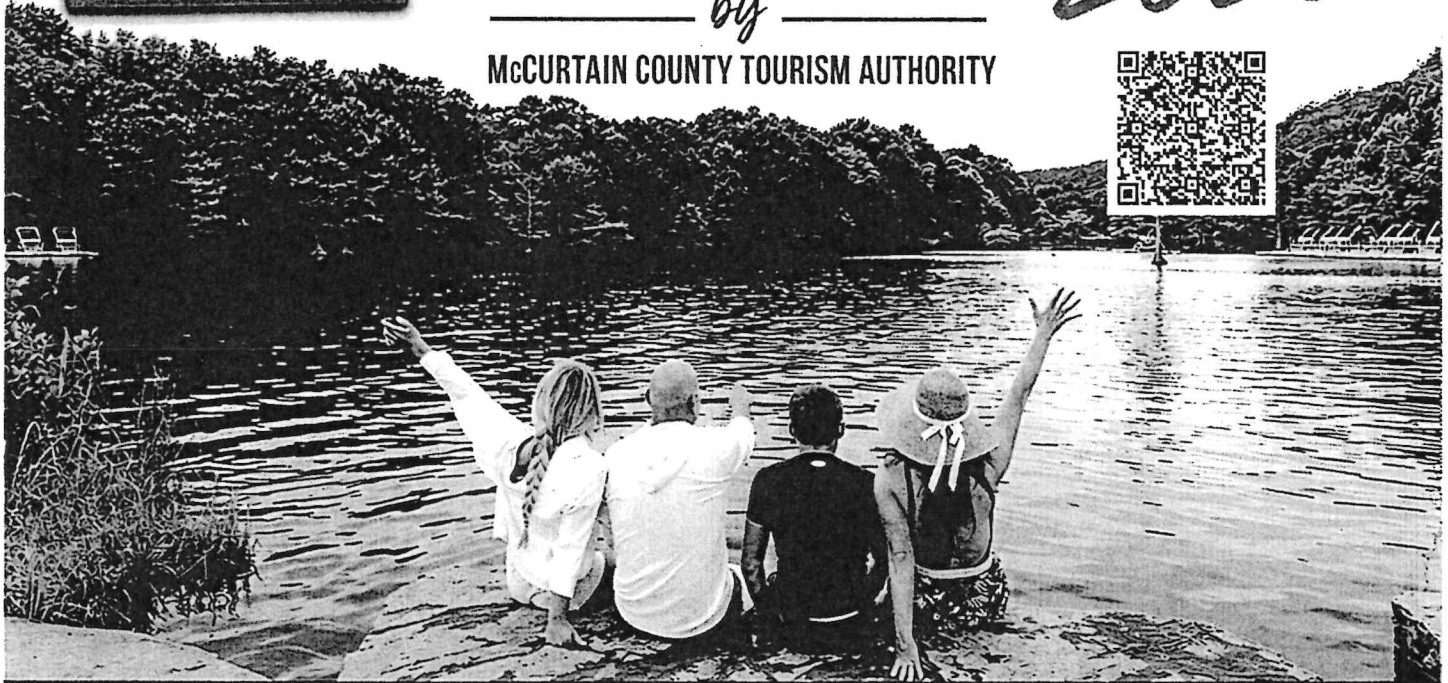
